AKTA PERHUTANAN NEGARA 1984

[AKTA 313]

- Bertujuan mengadakan peruntukan bagi pentadbiran, pengurusan dan pemuliharaan hutan dan pembangunan perhutanan di negeri-negeri
- Digubal menurut Fasal 1(b) Perkara 76 Perlembagaan Persekutuan
- Tidak boleh berkuatkuasa dalam sesuatu negeri melainkan ia telah diterimapakai oleh suatu undang-undang yang dibuat oleh Badan Perundangan Negeri menurut Fasal (3) Perkara 76

- Akta 313 diwartakan pada 31 Disember 1984 dan diterimapakai oleh semua negeri di Semenanjung melalui Enakmen Perhutanan (Pemakaian) negeri masing-masing.
- Telah dipinda pada tahun 1993 sejajar dengan perkembangan semasa sektor perhutanan serta berlakunya masalah pencerobohan dan kegiatan pembalakan haram secara berleluasa.

Logging activities puzzle villagers

ALOR STAR: Farmer Chatree Ai Ping has been anxiously waiting to have a rubber smallholding on state land about 50km from here.

However, he and his fellow villagers' applications have yet to be approved.

Last Saturday, however, the 29-year-old farmer from a small Malaysian Siamese village here, was surprised to find trees being felled at the four-hectare site in the Padang Terap district.

Fearing that it could be illegal loggers, he lodged a police report in nearby Naka.

On Wednesday, Chatree and his neighbours returned to the site and found that all the matured trees had been felled.

"It is very strange. If the state

government had authorised the felling of trees, we would have learnt about it because my friends and I have been eagerly waiting for our applications to be approved.

"The loggers must have come on the first day of Hari Raya. Anyway, if it was approved by the authorities, why was the work carried out on a public holiday? Won't it be costly for the state to hire contractors and workers to work on a public holiday?" he asked.

A check with the state Forestry Department revealed that approval had been given for some tree felling to be carried out in the area.

However, a department spokesman was unsure which part of the jungle had been earmarked for smallholdings.

Probe into illegal logging

TANJUNG KARANG: More than 650 hectares of forest reserve and state land, at three different sites have been ravaged and logged under the noses of the Forestry Department.

The Selangor government has launched a full-scale investigation into the scandal.

The ravaged sites at the Raja Musa and Sungai Sungai Forest Reserves are important water catchment areas.

"Their destruction can adversely affect the yield of the Tanjung Karang and Sekinchan."

Selangor executive councillor for Agriculture, Natural Resources and Entrepreneur Development Yaakob Sapari said the destruction was irresponsible and illegal.

This has been going on for between two and three years. We have not done anything to curb it."

Yaakob said an investigation was under way to find out why authorities had turned a blind eye to the destruction.

The Forestry Department had issued fines and seized excavators

of the culprits but nothing concrete was done to stop the deforestation.

Yaakob yesterday toured peat swamps, which had been devastated at the Raja Musa Forest Reserve, with Sekinchan assemblyman Ng Swee Lim.

The site borders padi fields in Tanjung Karang, while Sungai Tengi, which flows through the area, is an important water source for the region.

"I have ordered the department to cordon off the entrances into the encroached sites and to immediately start reforestation activities," he said.

Yaakob said all relevant authorities would be ordered to monitor the sites to prevent further destruction.

Local experts, politically linked syndicates were behind the deforestation.

"It is learnt they logged the area before selling small lots to unsuspecting buyers for between RM5,000 and RM8,500."

The buyers were then assured they would be able to obtain temporary occupation licences for the land, but under the previous state government.

Ng said he has received several

complaints from those who have been hoodwinked into buying the land, while the syndicate made a killing by raking in millions of ringgit.

"We believe at least 100 people have been conned into buying the land, while the syndicate made a killing by raking in millions of ringgit," said Ng.

Malaysia woos Arab tourists with eco-tourism

KUALA LUMPUR: Malaysia is making a strong presence at the four-day Arabian Travel Mart 2008 to woo Arab tourists to the country.

A total of 135 participants from 86 organisations are taking part in the mart which started on Wednesday and ends on Friday to sell packages to Arab tourists to showcase the various attractions on the Malaysian tourism calendar.

Tourism Malaysia director-general Datuk Mirza Mohamed Taiyab told a media conference yesterday that the number of Arab tourists to Malaysia was currently emphasising eco-tourism.

The events include the Colours of Malaysia, the Mega Sale and the Rainforest World Music Festival, Tourism Malaysia said.

Visitors will also be able to network with Malaysian organisations for potential business opportunities at the Tourism Malaysia booth at the Dubai World Trade Centre.

Last year, 38,170 visitors from the United Arab Emirates visited Malaysia, up 15.2% from last year.

Malaysia Airlines now operates seven daily flights between Dubai and Kuala Lumpur while Oman Air is expected to fly five times weekly beginning July, the Arabian summer holiday season.

Air Arabia will also be promoting Malaysia with daily services from Sharjah, UAE to Kuala Lumpur. It will be complemented by Air Yeti which will operate services between Kathmandu and Kuala Lumpur.

Bid to smuggle RM500,000 timber into Thailand foiled

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KUALA NERANG: State Forestry enforcement officers made an attempt to smuggle 1,300 pieces of illegally-logged timber worth RM500,000 into Thailand yesterday.

The timber was 10 bulldozers 50m from the border where the logs were piled.

The enforcement team failed to make any arrests as the smugglers escaped before they reached the area.

The timber was believed to have been felled at a 50ha area at the Hulu Muda forest reserve.

State director Kasm Osman said his officers had identified the timber as illegal.


Kasm said: "We may not have been able to catch them at the site where the logs were found but we know the company which felled the trees illegally and they will take action."

Although the enforcement officers had been tipped off to the presence of the timber, they had to comb the forest for an hour before stumbling on a cut of timber used to mark the illegal felling.

This led to the discovery of the logs and bulldozers.

The officers are investigating under Section 13 of the National Forestry Act 1984 over the illegal felling.

Those convicted could be fined up to RM500,000 and jailed up to 20 years.



Cengal RM360,000 dirampas

ROMPIN: Jabatan Perhutani tanah Pahang berjaya merampas 33 kayu cengal bernilai kira-kira RM360,000 yang dimulakan dalam lima lori ketika sekatan jalan di persimpangan Cenderawasih, di sini, semalam.

Turut ditahan 14 lelaki berumur antara 27 hingga 47 tahun yang menjadikan Hutan Simpan Lesong sebagai lokasi mengelukkan kayu tanpa lesen.

Pegawai Hutan Rompin, Mohd Shahrir Azrin Salleh, berkata pihaknya melakukannya intipan dua minggu sebelum mengadakan sekatan jalan jam 3 pagi kelmarin.

"Beliau berkata, setiap lori membawa antara empat hingga enam kayu cengal dipercayai untuk dihantar ke kilang papan di Lembah Klang."

Katanya, operasi dianggotai 19 penguat kuasa negeri dan daerah itu turut merampas dua pacuan empat roda, dua jentera pengangkat kaya balak dan sebuah kereta Proton Iswara.

"Sindiket berkenaan melakukannya kegiatan haram itu secara berperingkat pada masa dan tarikh berbeza untuk mengelak dikesan oleh pihak berkuasa."

"Kita percaya kegiatan ini

dialangi seorang kakitangan Jabatan Perhutani Pahang yang digantung perkhidmatan," katanya.

Beliau berkata, tidak diharapkan kegiatan itu dirancang rapi terutama membabitkan lokasi penebangan balak termasuk penggunaan pas palsu memindah kayu.

Beliau berkata, barga bakal terutama cengal mampu mencecah sehingga RM4,000 satu juga mendorong kegiatan itu.

Katanya, semua yang dihantam akan direman sehingga siasatan selesai dan diempatkan di lokasi Balai Polis Rompin.



KESIMPULAN

Hasrat Kerajaan membuat pindaan ke atas Akta 313 adalah bagi memantapkan aspek pengukuhan aktiviti membanteras kegiatan pembalakan serta memperkasa aktiviti pemeliharaan dan pemuliharaan biodiversiti.



KAWASAN BERHUTAN DI MALAYSIA (juta hektar)




